



Webberville Consolidated Drain Project Construction Paving Notice September 19, 2020

Dear Webberville Village and Leroy Township Resident:

In continuation and eventual completion of the storm sewer work for our project, our contractor, Mead Bros., will be paving the following streets, Franklin, East Chestnut, Summit, South Clark, Oak, Maple, East and West Walnut, Franklin, South Howard, Monroe and Gramer Road starting on Tuesday, September 22nd, good weather and other construction logistics permitting. **Please see location map on the reverse side.** The first layer of pavement is needed in some of these locations where gravel grades exist, and it is anticipated that once that is done, all single course paved areas will receive installation of the top coat or wearing course early in the next following week, good weather and other conditions permitting. Current paving preparatory work in these gravel areas includes sub grade gravel placement, grading and rolling and structure raising. Only emergency vehicles and local traffic will be able to pass through the areas as necessary. You will also be advised by signage and flag persons as to safe travel on recently paved areas when they are safe enough and cool enough to travel on.
